5-year Results | October 2018 - October 2023

With the support of a five-year grant from the U.S. Department of Education, the National Center for Families Learning (NCF) established the Nebraska Statewide Family Engagement Center (SFEC) to build a systematic, high impact statewide infrastructure of family engagement to improve student development and raise academic achievement. As part of its work, the Nebraska SFEC instituted:

- A statewide professional development network to support capacity-building for family/school partnerships
- School-based family literacy programs in 14 Local Education Agencies (LEAs) across the state
- Parent leadership opportunities to deepen family/school connections and incorporate family voice into education decision-making


