



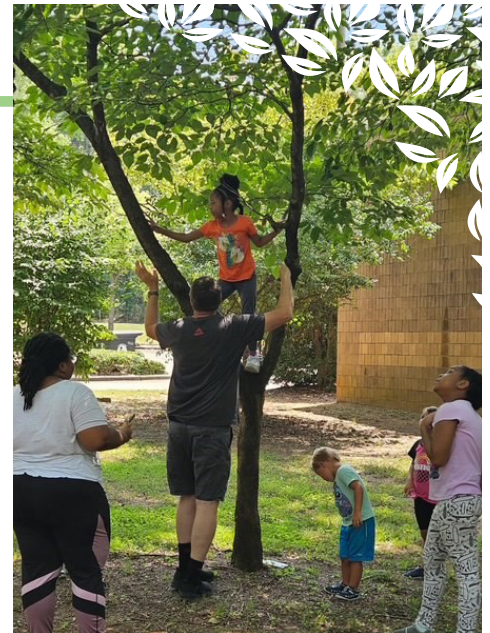
Helping families discover the outdoors together

NCFL's Let's Learn Together Outside (LLTO) 4-week playgroup curriculum ensures that all parenting adults have the tools they need to help children gain the full benefits of outdoor learning and play. Designed for families with children ages 3-5, LLTO focuses on improving access to and enjoyment of natural spaces while building a foundation for kindergarten readiness.

Program Goals

- Foster child development and connection to nature through play-based learning and adult skill-building.
- Enhance children's early learning, especially around outdoor play, oral language, and literacy.
- Increase opportunities for families to connect and learn from each other.
